1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Gibney Classic is organised by Howth Yacht Club Ltd., Middle Pier, Howth, Co. Dublin, D13V6E3.

2 RULES AND ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Races will be sailed under the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the ISA, the rules of each class concerned and this Notice of Race except as modified by the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.
- 2.2 Entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Race Committee.
- 2.3 Eligible boats are those in the Classes that comply with the relevant handicapping system, rules and the entry requirements.
- 2.4 It is strongly recommended that all boats carry VHF Radios.
- 2.5 The Gibney Classic will be the scoring race for HYC Club Racing on Saturday, 17th June 2017
- 2.6 Entry Disclaimer
It is the Competitor's decision to enter the Regatta or to start in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Regatta is at their sole, exclusive risk, in every respect. By way of entry to the Regatta, competitors shall indemnify the Howth Yacht Club, its officers, members, servants and agents in respect of all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the Regatta. Competitors shall acknowledge that Howth Yacht Club, its officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the Regatta or howsoever arising in connection with these events.
- 2.7 Insurance
All boats shall have adequate third party insurance cover. All owners / competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owners / competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry

5 ENTRIES

5.2 The entry fee is €15.00

6 SAIL NUMBERS/ IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Each boat shall show a distinguishing number on its spinnaker and on each side of the mainsail, which shall be the same number as declared on the Entry Form. Where relevant, the same number shall be shown on the genoa. Should a boat wish to change its sail number from that on the Entry Form, notice shall be given to the Race Officer before the warning Signal of the particular race concerned.

6.2 Classes 1, 2, 3 and Non Spinnaker Cruisers shall fly the relevant class numeral pennant from the backstay. Any boat not doing so shall be disqualified.

7 HANDICAPS

The following Handicap Data will be used in this event: -

7.1 Cruiser Classes 1, 2, 3 & Non Spinnaker : Boats will race under the relevant IRC Handicap System and/or the ECHO Handicap System.

7.2 Cruisers will be divided into the following classes:

Class 1 - IRC 0.980 and above;

Class 2 - IRC 0.919 to 0.979;

Class 3 - IRC 0.919 and below

7.3 There will be no crew limitations under IRC.

7.4 For ECHO Handicap, any change in the normal helm shall be notified to the Race Office results@hyc.ie in a timely fashion. Failure to fulfil this requirement will render a boat liable to a penalty.

8 PRIZES

8.1 Prizes will be presented in Gibneys, Malahide as soon as practical after racing

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 Sailing instructions and course cards will be available in HYC Marina Office and online from Wednesday 14th June 2017.

10 MARINA BERTHS

10.1 Howth Marina, Friday 16th June 2017
