



COVID 19 Regulations

1. Entry to HYC is prohibited if you are; currently diagnosed as infected with COVID-19, awaiting the results COVID-19 test, subject to a quarantine requirement, including foreign travel, or have been in contact within the last 14 days with a person diagnosed as having COVID-19.
2. Social distancing of 2 metres to be observed at all times.
3. Until further notice, face coverings must be worn when inside the Clubhouse, the Marina and Administration Offices unless seated and must be worn again on departing through the building. Serving staff are required to wear face masks. Face coverings are not required outside the club buildings. PPE is required on the Crane Platform
4. Smoking is not permitted on the walkway extending from the Asgard Room to the Bar, as some members have been ignoring SD requirements while smoking in that area.
5. A maximum of 6 people may be seated at a table or at any meeting within the club.
6. A maximum of 15 people are permitted for outdoor dining. Indoor hospitality is not permitted.
7. Tables may be reserved from 12.30 until 6.30pm daily up to 24 hours in advance through our online booking form or by emailing catering@hyc.ie . Walk-in bookings will be accepted on the day if the club has capacity and is within the limits. [Online booking form](#)
8. On being seated at the reserved table face masks may be removed but must be worn again if leaving the table.
9. Serving Staff shall ensure that persons seated are members. If there is a doubt the members name and membership card number should be recorded.
10. If there is a non-member at a table a Covid-19 Declaration Form must be given to the member in accordance with tracking requirements; details recorded must include the member's name, time and date together with the name and contact details for all guests.
11. A food order must be placed by each person before any beverage order can be taken - there can be no exceptions. The minimum food order for each person at a table is €9.
12. The same server shall attend each table and is responsible for sanitising it once the table is cleared.
13. Rooms can only be booked by members of which one must be nominated the Covid-19 officer for any group and assume full responsibly for compliance.
14. Toilets will be sanitised twice a day and other touch surfaces sanitised regularly.
15. Contravention or ignoring procedures will be reported to the Covid Officer and may make an individual liable for Club disciplinary procedures. Covid Officers are provided with a green Covid vest. Please comply with their instructions.
16. Following the latest directive members and friends can continue to meet socially in other settings, but only with people from one other household.
