Change to Notice of Race: No 3

Amendment 3a

Rules relating to the other vessels using Howth Harbour.

Addition of:

9.4 [DP] COLREG rules and Fishery Harbour Centre (FHC) Bylaws apply between the boats competing and the other vessels using Howth Harbour. These other vessels have restricted navigation in Howth Harbour, its entrance and the navigation channels to the west and south of Ireland's Eye. Competing boats must give way to those vessels. Follow the instructions of the Harbour Master when entering, leaving, or within the Howth FHC.

Amendment 3b

Rule changes to support the local provisions of the J24 Association of Ireland

Addition to 9.3

J24 Class Rule C.10.2 is changed by GR4.7

Change to 10.2

For Cruiser-racers: Yellow flag Scoring Penalties will replace One and Two Turn Penalties.

For boats in the J24 Class: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing.

Please note that the following changes have been made to the ICRA General Rules:

1.5.2 When crew registration is required, the substitution of crew is not allowed unless approved by the Race Committee.

5.1.5 The approximate magnetic compass bearing from the Committee Vessel to the windward mark will be communicated prior to the start.

GR4.7 J24 ONE DESIGN

When a class or prize is described as “J24 One Design” in the rules 4.7.1 When, through no fault of her own, a boat cannot race under her sail number or the owner’s personal sail number, she may race under another sail number provided that a request has been made in writing and agreed upon by the race officer of the course she is racing on.

4.7.2 A spare spinnaker may be carried provided that its colour has been notified at registration.

4.7.3 In the event of damage that is beyond repair while afloat, the damaged spinnaker may be substituted by the spare spinnaker which shall then be used for the remainder of racing.

Amendment 3c

Registration

Addition of:

4.5 Registration [GR1.5]

Boats shall register at the race office at Howth Yacht Club between:

1700 – 1800 Thursday 7th

0930 – 1000 Friday 8th

Boats shall register their crew.

Boats intending to race under a secondary cert shall declare this intent at registration.

J24 Class boats: shall register the colour of any spare spinnaker.



IRC Certificates do not have to be presented at registration. Competitors shall ensure that the rating recorded in their Certificate Authority's database is correct at the Rating Deadline.

For Irish-registered boats, their Certificate Authority is Irish Sailing.

For UK-registered boats, their Certificate Authority is the RORC IRC Office.
