### **CHANGE TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS                      NO: 1**

The following Sailing Instructions are changed:

#### **SI. 1 RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This Sailing Instruction is changed by the addition of the following:

1.5 Notwithstanding GR 2.3.3, the J24 Class rule regarding crew weight limitation shall apply.

#### **SI 3 SCHEDULE OF RACES**

This Sailing Instruction is changed by the addition of the following:

3.3 Notwithstanding the schedule of races listed in SI 3, the Race Committee will decide on the day of racing whether it will set a Round the Cans course or a W/L course.

#### **APPENDIX A. COURSES AND MARKS**

Sailing Instruction A1.1.1 is changed by the addition of the following:

If only one set of windward marks (windward and spreader) is laid, they will be designated as the upper windward marks (inshore A: large orange dumpy, inshore B: large yellow dumpy)) and all boats shall round the relevant marks for their course.

#### **APPENDIX A2. ROUND THE CANS**

Sailing Instruction A2.1 is changed to read:

The selected course will be displayed on the Committee Vessel. It will be displayed as a three-digit number that calls up a course from the 'Round the Cans' course card, which forms part of





these Sailing Instructions or, alternatively, it may be displayed as the sequence of marks to be rounded with the marks selected from the lists shown in Sections A2 and A3.

The list of marks that may be used for Round the Cans courses and their approximate positions is shown in the table at A2.3. All of the marks listed may not be laid.

Where the mark sequence is displayed, a single letter shall denote each mark (see A2.3) and all shall be left to port unless the letter is enclosed in a box, such marks to be left to starboard.

Where the option of using a course from the 'Round the Cans' course card is being used, the three-digit number will indicate the course. The marks to be rounded and the sequence will be discovered by finding (reading from the left) the first two numbers displayed on the Committee Vessel in the left-hand column of the course card and then reading across that row to the column headed by the third number displayed. The mark sequence found at that intersection shall be the course sailed by the next Class to start.

In addition to the display of the course numeral or mark sequence, the course to be sailed will be broadcast on the relevant VHF channel for the Fleet
