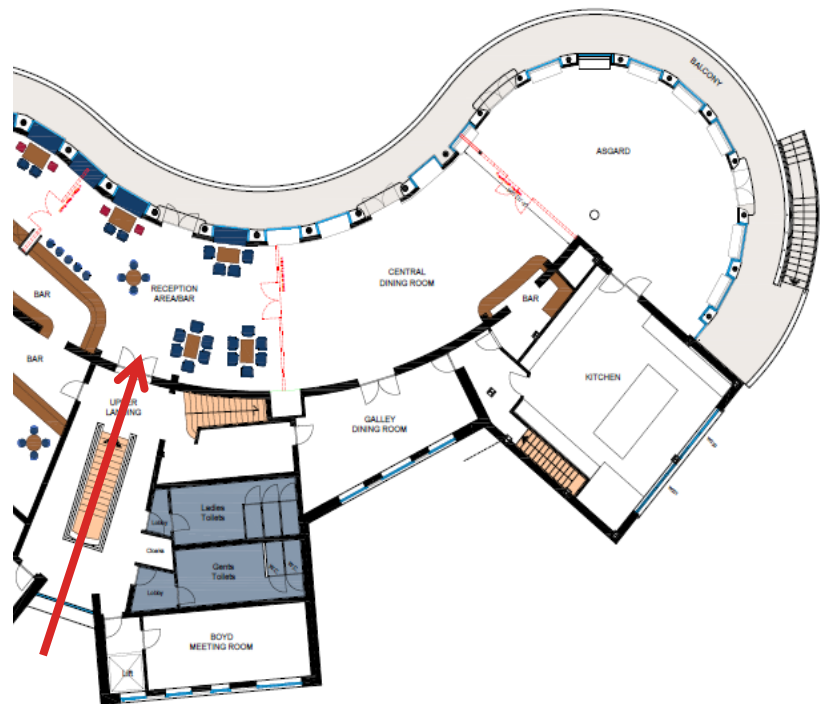
WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

WHERE SHOULD I GO WHEN IN HOWTH YACHT CLUB?

Take the stairs to
SECOND FLOOR



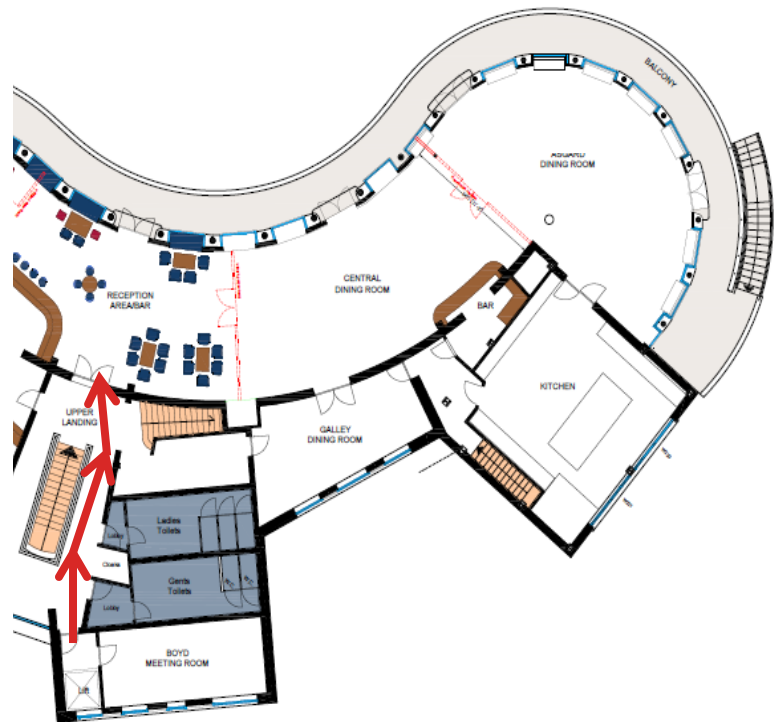
Then go through the

in front of you

This will lead you to
the **Dining Room & Bar**



WHERE SHOULD I GO IF I NEED AN ELEVATOR?

The **LIFT** is located on the **RIGHT TO THE ENTRANCE** beyond the **WOODEN DOOR**



On the **FIRST FLOOR** go straight **through the WHITE DOOR** in front of you and along the **CORRIDOR**

Pass **through the GLASS DOOR**



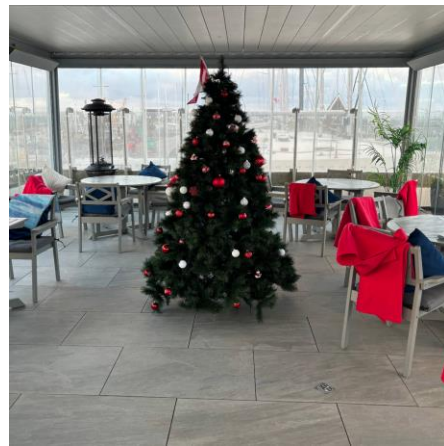
WHERE SHOULD I GO WHEN IN THE DINING ROOM & BAR?

If you have booked a table:

You will be guided to one of our **indoor seating** areas by one of our staff



Upon request you can also be access **outdoor seating** in the pergola if available.





WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

Approximately 100 PEOPLE
in attendance, including
ADULTS and **CHILDREN**

1. You'll **arrive** at HYC, where it might be busy and festive.
2. Inside, there will be people greeting you, with **some noise** from chatter and music.
3. You will be **guided to your seat** by one of the staff
4. You can **enjoy a festive meal** with options like turkey, sides, and desserts.
5. A **quiet area will be available** if you need a break.
6. You can leave whenever you feel ready.

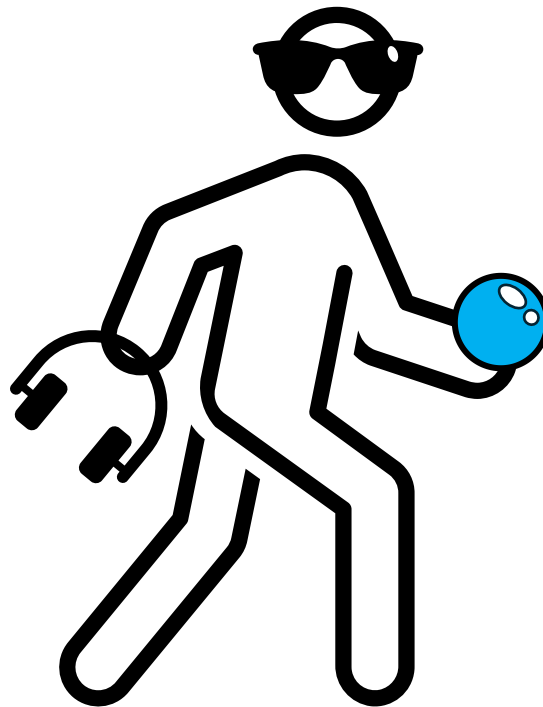

You can move around or leave the dining room **ANYTIME** during the event.



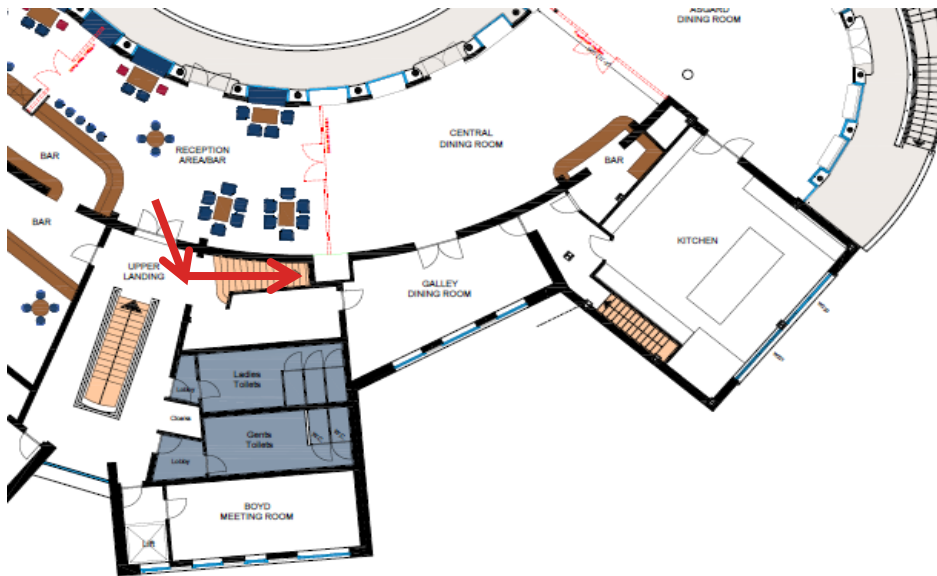
You can also use **EAR DEFENDERS** and **SENSORY ITEMS**

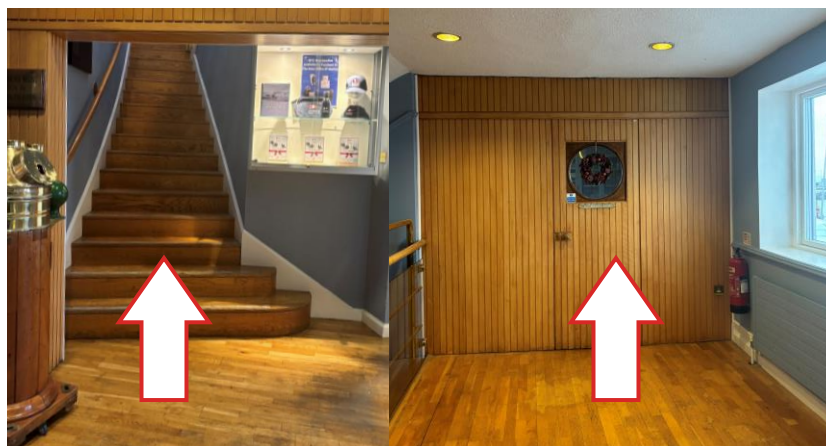
WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I NEED A BREAK FROM THE FESTIVITIES?

The **SENSORY ROOM** for this event is the **CENTENARY ROOM**.



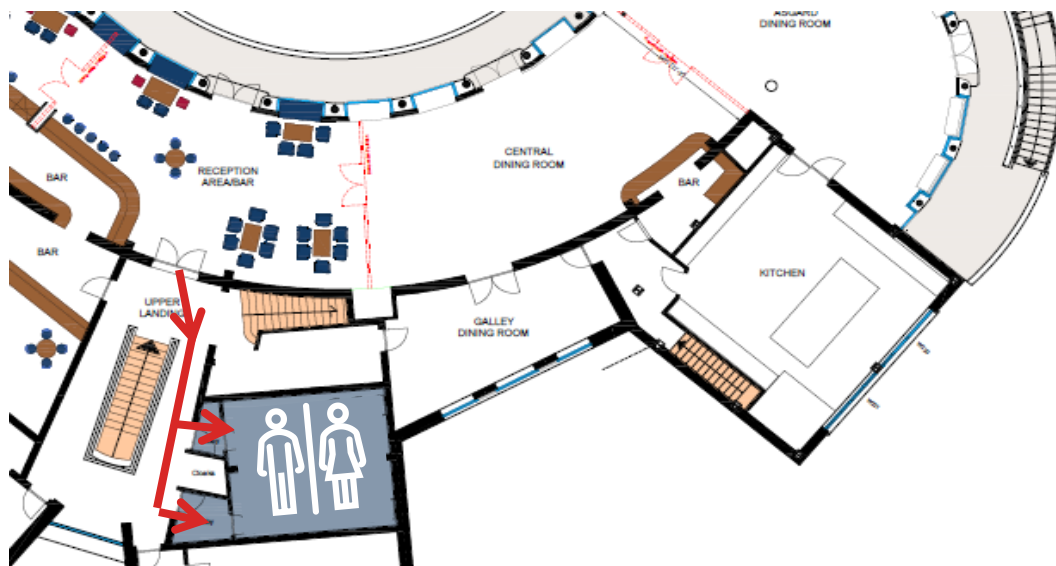
Located directly outside of the dining room at the

CENTENARY ROOM ENTRANCE



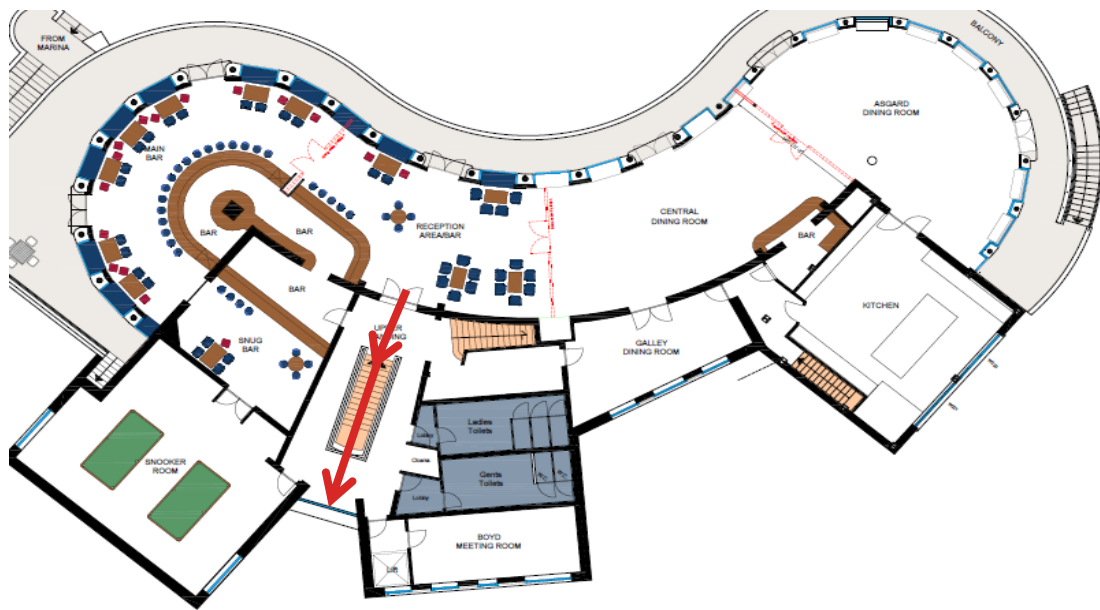
WHAT IF I NEED THE BATHROOM?
