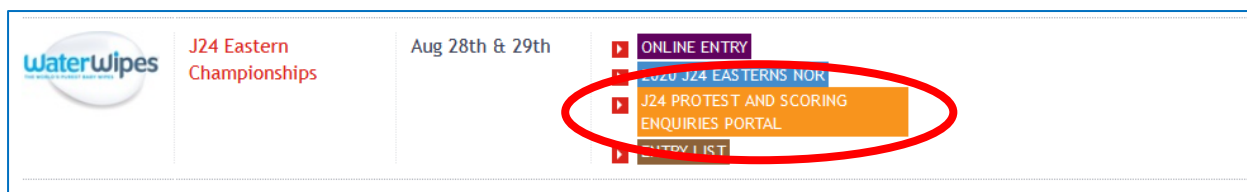


Dear J24ers,


Remember, a protest need only identify
