SI 6.3 is replaced with

6.3 Eight races are scheduled for all classes.

One race on each of the following Saturdays, **September 17 and October 1, 15 and 22**

Two races are scheduled for Saturdays, **September 24 and October 8** with formats to be decided on the day.

However, the Race Committee may change the days on which two races are sailed. The intention to sail two races will be posted at least 24 hours before the scheduled start of the first race.

SI 6.6 is added


6.6 If Flag F' is displayed with repeated sound signals at a mark of the course, boats shall round that mark and sail directly from that mark to the finish line.

Appendix to Sailing Instructions

S.I. 6.4 refers to the option available to the Race Committee to set a Windward/Leeward course. Should this option be chosen, Flag 'W' will be displayed afloat.

Course Diagram:



Gate Marks: Yellow for inshore fleet and Black for offshore fleet.

NOTE. There is only ONE set of gate marks on each course

For Inshore fleets:

Cruisers 3 and Puppeteers use the **Outer** Windward (Black) and Gate (Yellow)

Howth 17s and Squibs use the **Inner** Windward (yellow) and Gate (Yellow)

For Offshore fleets:

Cruisers 1 and 2 use the **Outer** the Windward (Black) and Gate (Black)

Non-Spinnaker classes 4 and 5 use the **Inner** Windward (Yellow) and Gate (Black)

Where Windward/Leeward courses are chosen, the S.I.s are changed as follows:

ADD THE FOLLOWING TO S.I.s 6.1 D & 6.2 D with: The number of rounds for each Class will be displayed on the relevant Committee Starting Vessel not later than the Preparatory Signal for that Class.
