## NOTICE OF RACE

- The Organising Authority (OA) is Howth Yacht Club CLG.
- The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of Irish Sailing and the relevant Class Rules.
- 1.2. HYC Female any membership category must helm the boat
- 1.3. Male crews are permitted up to a max 2 males on a 4-5 person boat or 1 male on a two-person boat

### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SI)

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions will be available online on the HYC website no later than Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2026

### 3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The official notice board is beside the Marina Office and via a What's App group

### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The Event is open to the following classes

- 4.2. Eligible boats and individuals may enter the Event by registering online at <https://hyc.ie/open-Events> before Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June Middy.
- 4.3. To be considered an entry in the Event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the OA subject to a late fee.

## 15. SCORING

## 16. DATA PROTECTION

**16.1.** Competitors give their consent to the OA to use or to license the use of their name, comments, photographs and likeness as it sees fit for the promotion of the Event. The OA reserves the right to uses or to license the use of any images and sound recording during the Event free of charge.

## 17. RISK STATEMENT

17.1 Rule 3 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.'

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- (g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event;
