SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

AMENDMENT 02

Due to errors in the URL links published

Sailing instruction 9 is changed to read as follows:

Hearing Requests and Scoring Inquiries should be submitted online, within the protest time limit, at https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/protests/new?event_id=15543

The Protest Time Limit for the Inshore fleet is 60 minutes from the time of finish of the last boat in the last race sailed on the day by a Class assigned to the Inshore fleet.

The protest time limit for the Offshore fleet is 60 minutes from the time of the finish of the last boat in the last race sailed on the day by a Class assigned to the Offshore fleet.

Notices of protests by the Race Committee will be posted at <https://tinyurl.com/yut4dsbv> This changes Rule 61.1(b).

The protest flag exemption for boats less than six metres shall not apply. This changes Rule 61.1(a) (2).

Sailing instruction 10 is changed to read as follows:

Protest hearings will be held on the Tuesday following the race in question at 1930 in Howth

On the last scheduled day of racing protests will be held on that day.

The schedule of protest hearings will be posted online, 30 minutes after the protest time limit, at <https://tinyurl.com/4na24vyy>

The listing of a boat on this schedule shall constitute informing her of a hearing under Rule 63.2.

Parties involved shall be present with their witnesses at the time and place indicated on the schedule.

On the last scheduled day of racing a request to reopen a hearing shall be delivered to the Protest Committee not later than 30 minutes after the party was informed of the decision. This changes Rule 66.
